Teacher's Choice +
Parent Involvement

- Teacher calls student's grown-up to inform and brainstorm solutions.
  - Teacher continues to use positive behavior interventions and natural consequences.
  - Possible lunch detention

----- level 3

Teacher's Choice

- Teacher uses **positive behavior interventions and natural consequences** to problem solve the behavior
- A summary of the behavior will be sent home in the yellow folder or Remind message. Acknowledgement of receipt may be required at this time.

Level 2

Student's Choice

- Student and teacher collaborate to find a solution.
- A summary of the behavior *may* be sent home in the yellow folder or Remind message.

Level 1

3 Reminders

• Student is given **3 reminders to stop and correct** their behavior.
