



Tuition and Scholarship Information

Tuition

In accordance with the school's mission and vision, Logos Academy Harrisburg serves students from diverse economic and cultural backgrounds. To this end, tuition, scholarships, and payment plans are designed to ensure that a Logos Academy education is accessible to those who might not otherwise have access to private education.

- Almost all of our students receive significant need-based scholarships that cover 85 percent to 90 percent of the tuition costs.
- Any family that does not qualify for financial aid may be eligible for additional scholarships.

Scholarships

The total cost to educate a student at Logos Academy Harrisburg is about \$9,500. The “family share” of tuition at Logos Academy Harrisburg is affordable for all of our families. Tuition is calculated based on household income and family size. The minimum tuition per student for K-4th is \$80/month; the minimum tuition per student for pre-K is \$40/month. Tuition is paid over 10 months, from August through May.

Scholarships are determined using current poverty rates, household size, adjusted gross income, and Logos Harrisburg's cost-to-educate. Using these variables, Logos Academy Harrisburg determines an affordable rate of tuition.

Adjusted Gross Income (AGI) is based on the previous year's tax return. The AGI can be found here:

- 1040 A, Line 21

Our scholarship application process is very straightforward, and a tuition discount is offered for simply completing the application, *even if you are found to be not eligible for a scholarship*. Families may apply for this need-based scholarship with a printed application. The application requires a non-refundable \$25 fee. Because almost every family will qualify for significant tuition assistance, we strongly encourage every family to apply. We are happy to assist you in completing the application.

Families that do not complete a scholarship application will be charged the full annual tuition of \$8500 per student.
